

Acknowledgements and Disclaimers

This “snapshot,” provides comparative data for many categories of information included in the 1994 Profile of Health and Human Services in Ventura County and in the updated 2002 Profile.

In 1994, the efforts of many organizations and individual volunteers and participants resulted in the publication of a landmark document titled: The 1994 Profile of Health & Human Services in Ventura County. The report’s introduction characterized this document as follows: “This Health and Human Services Profile of Ventura County is the most comprehensive such undertaking by a consortium of public and private Ventura County organizations to date. . . . The Profile details existing services and existing needs, and ties this information to existing socio-economic data. Individual agencies are encouraged to study this Profile, draw their own conclusions and set their own goals and agendas based on those conclusions.”

The 1994 report was produced through a collaborative effort of California Lutheran University, the County of Ventura, Interface Children Family Services, the United Way of Ventura County, and the Ventura County Community Foundation. Additional acknowledgements were made in the report of the “literally hundreds of people,” and their organizations who contributed time, information and ideas to the project.

The 2002 Community Profile of Health and Human Services was created through the efforts of a second collaboration, involving The Ventura County Community Foundation, the Ventura County Human Services Agency, The United Way of Ventura County, the Ventura County Health Care Agency including Public Health, Behavioral Health and the Ventura County Medical Center, Interface Children, Family Services, the Ventura County Medical Resource Foundation, the Center for Excellence at California State University, Channel Islands, and California Lutheran University. Unaffiliated committee members Kristina Brook, Jerry Beckerman and Dr. Elizabeth Trebow also gave significant time to the project.

Cautions and Disclaimers Regarding the Use and Interpretation of Statistical Data

The Profiles of Health and Human Services related information produced in 1994 and in 2002 contain literally thousands of data points and statistics drawn from a wide variety of public reports, government and non-profit agency publications and web-sites, and other publicly accessible sources.

We have made every effort to ensure that we have accurately reported the data gathered from these various sources and that our characterizations and portrayals of these data are consistent with their original definitions, methods of collection and interpretation.

Nevertheless, users of this report and related profiles of information are cautioned that errors of accuracy or interpretation are possible within these documents as well as within the source documents of the various source organizations. Furthermore, many specific data items are defined for specialized purposes, making “common sense,” interpretations somewhat risky. It can also be the case the definitions used for specific data items and values change over time, making it difficult to compare seemingly similar data items from one year to another.

Wherever possible, we have provided source information for the data elements and summaries included in these profiles. Users are encouraged to visit the web-sites and publications of these source agencies to help facilitate the accurate reporting and interpretation of technical information.

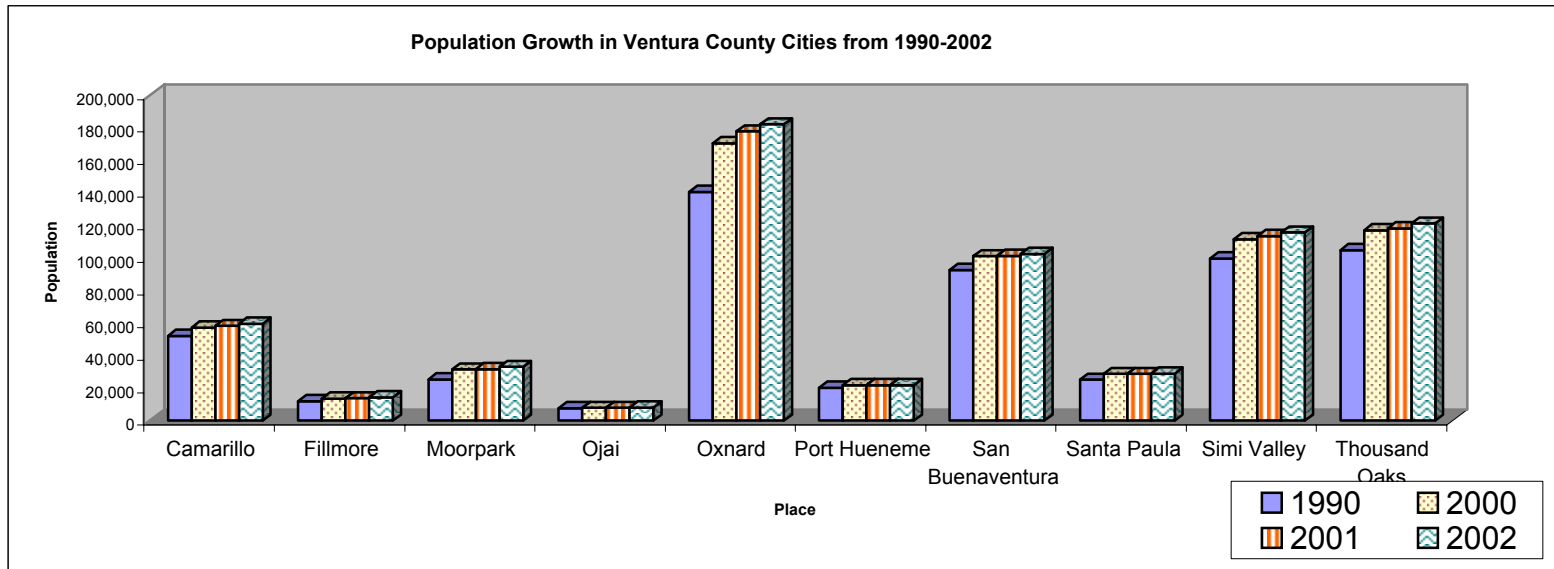

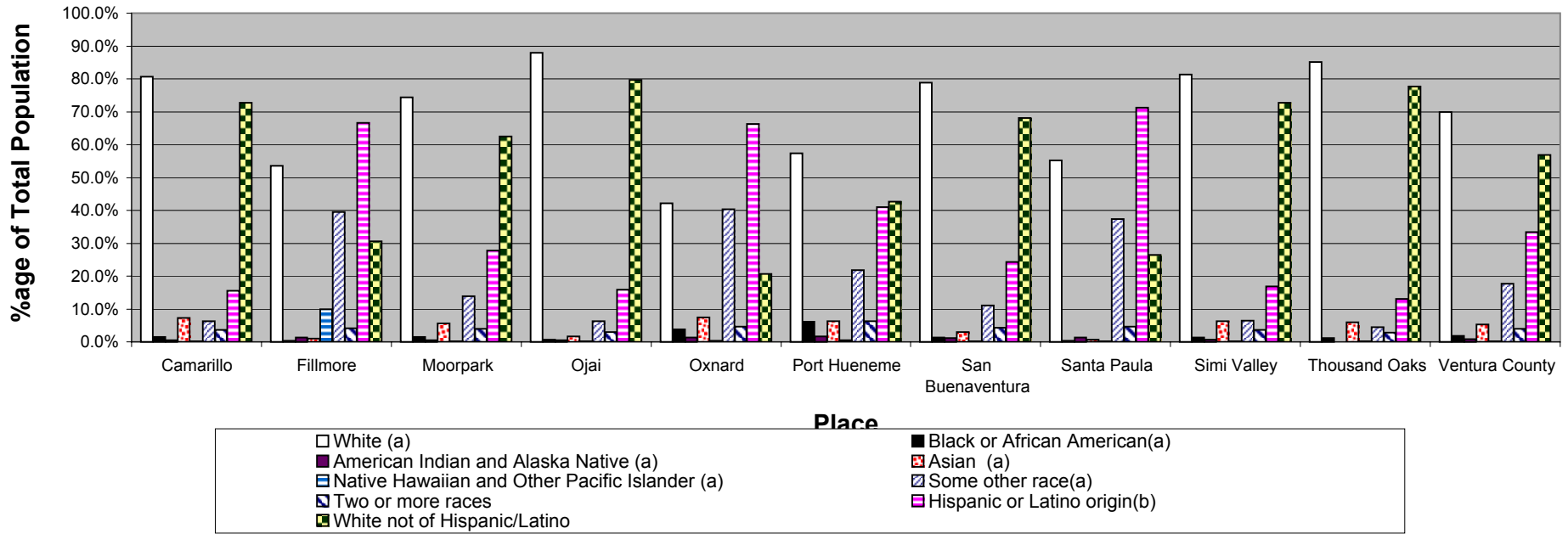

Ethnicity of the Population in Ventura County Cities

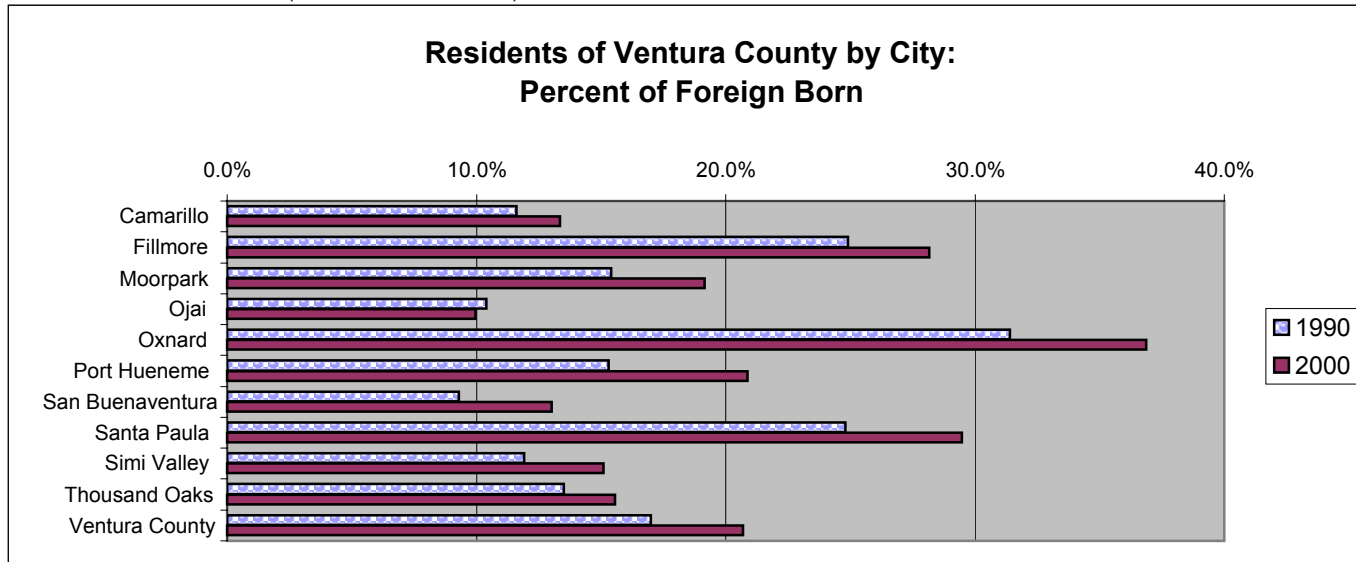

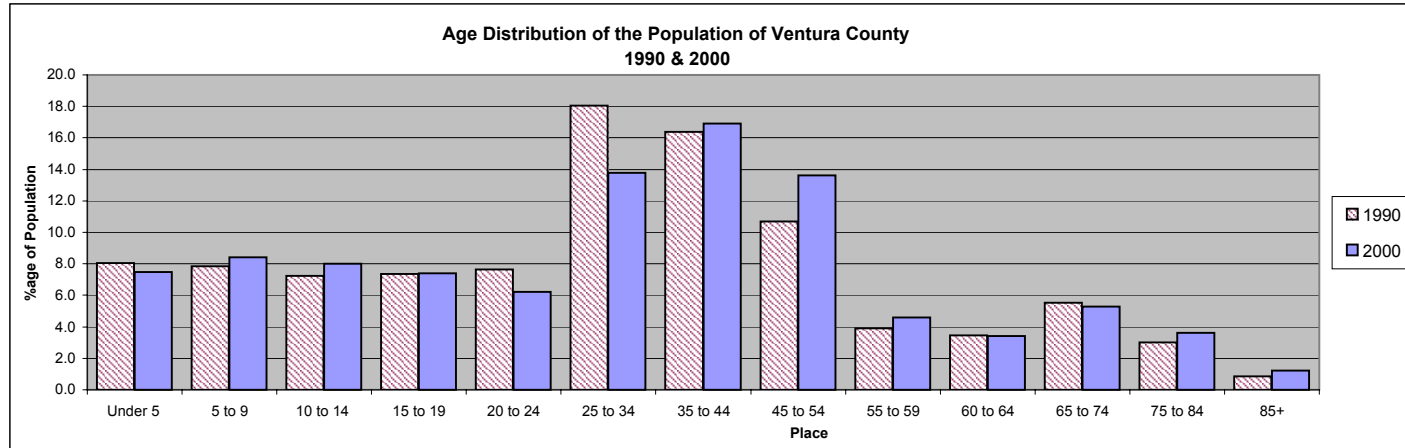

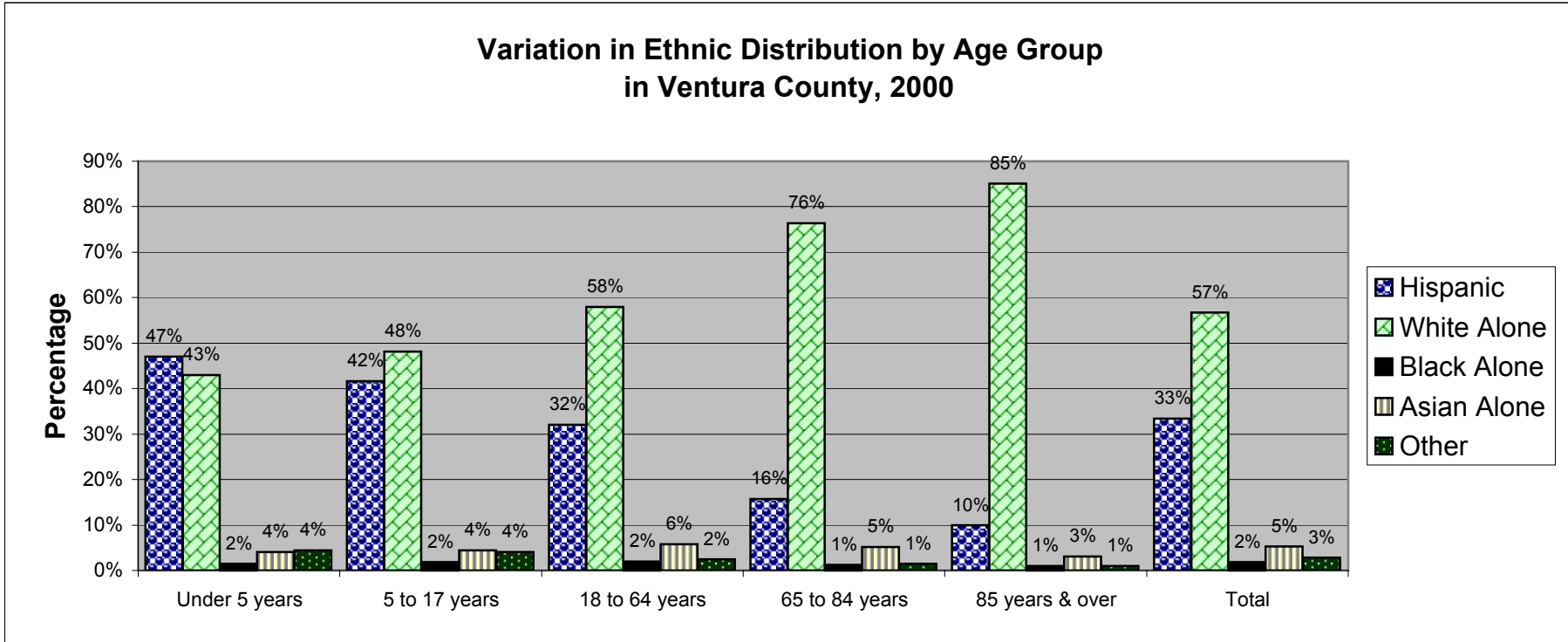

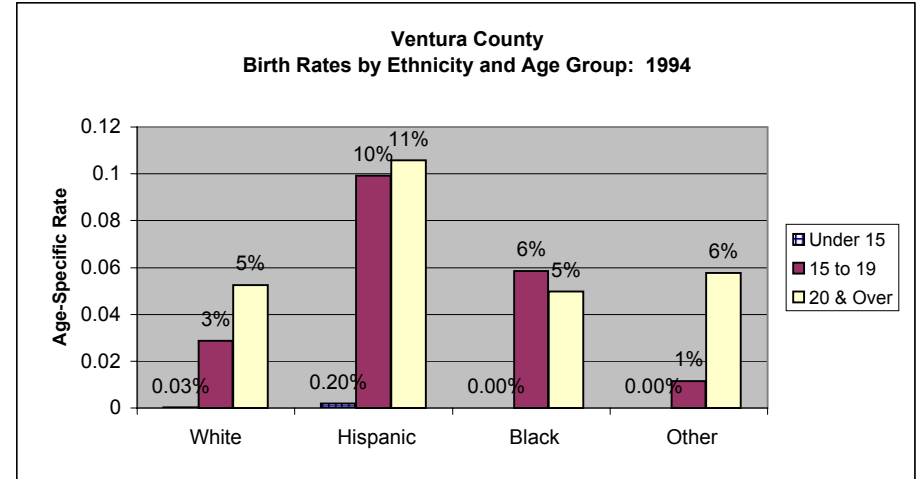
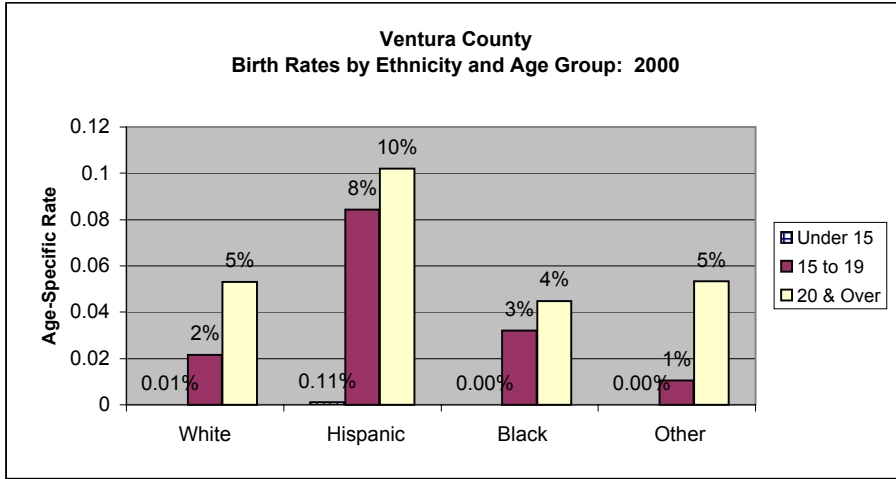


Variation in Race/Ethnic Distribution by Age Group

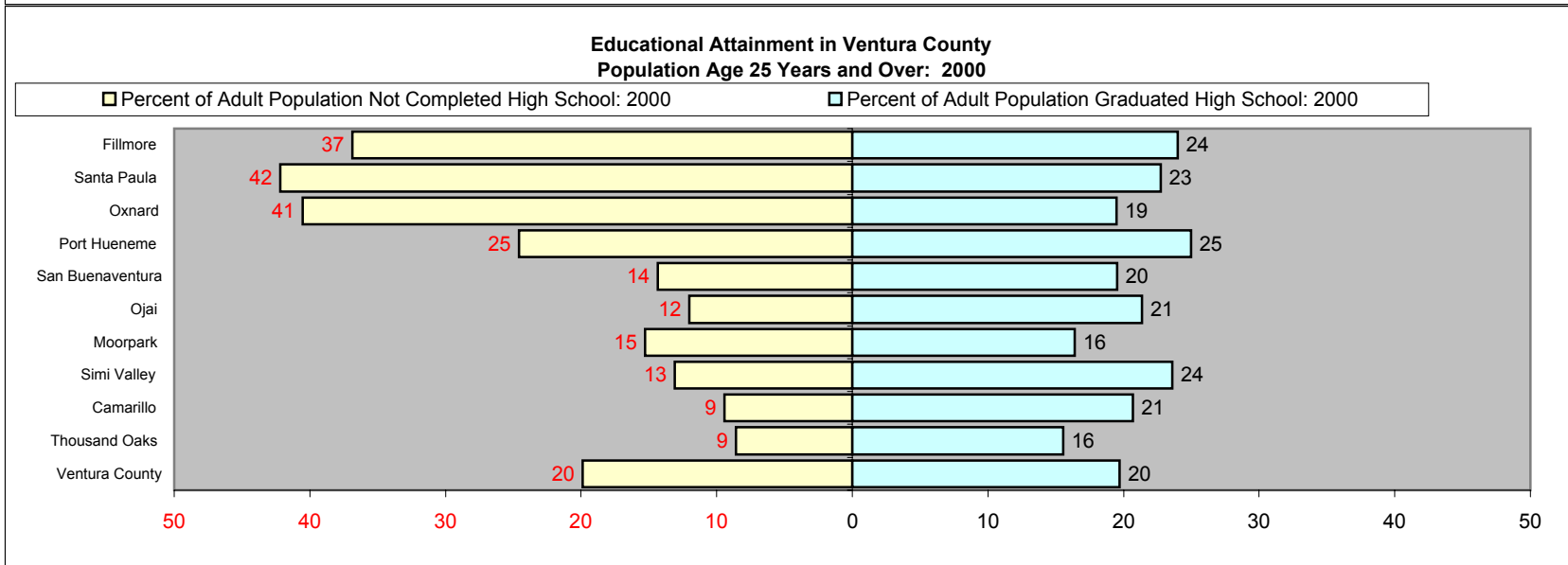

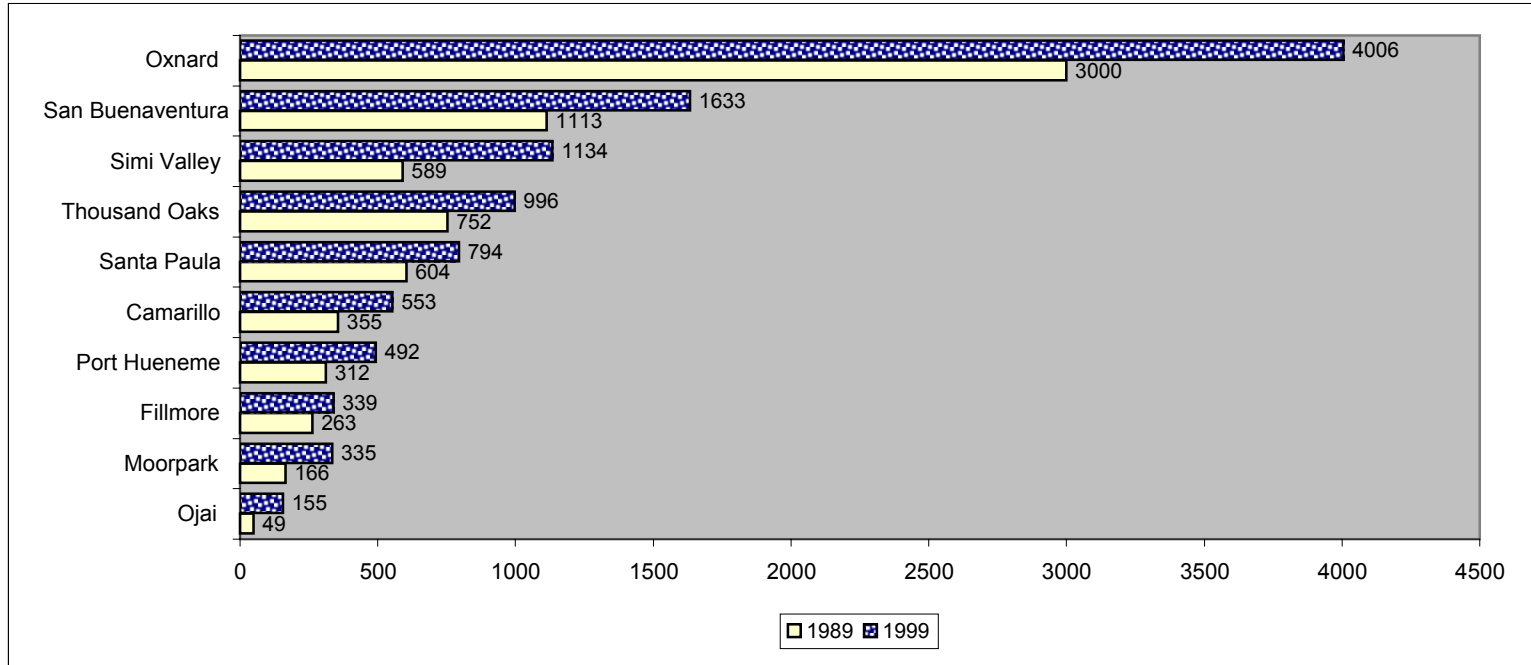

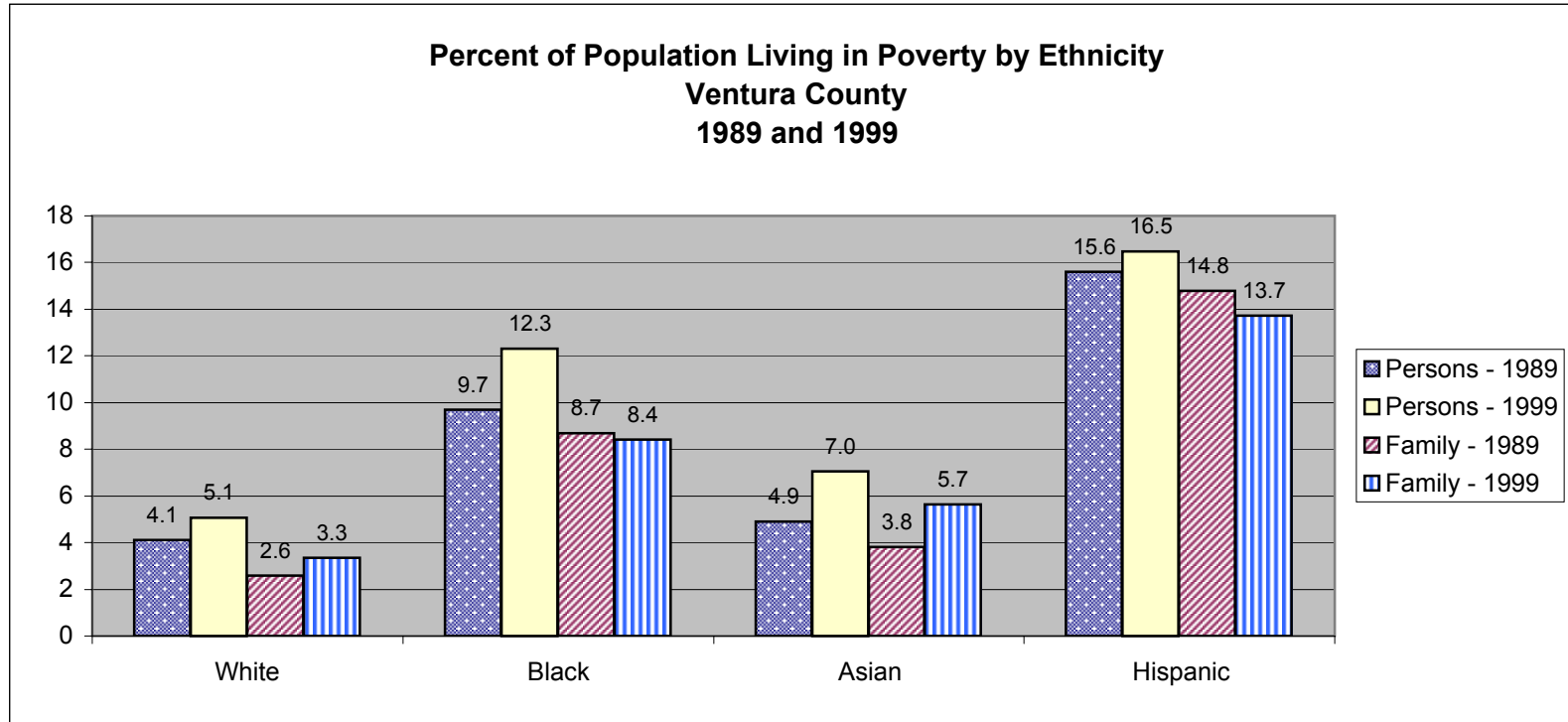

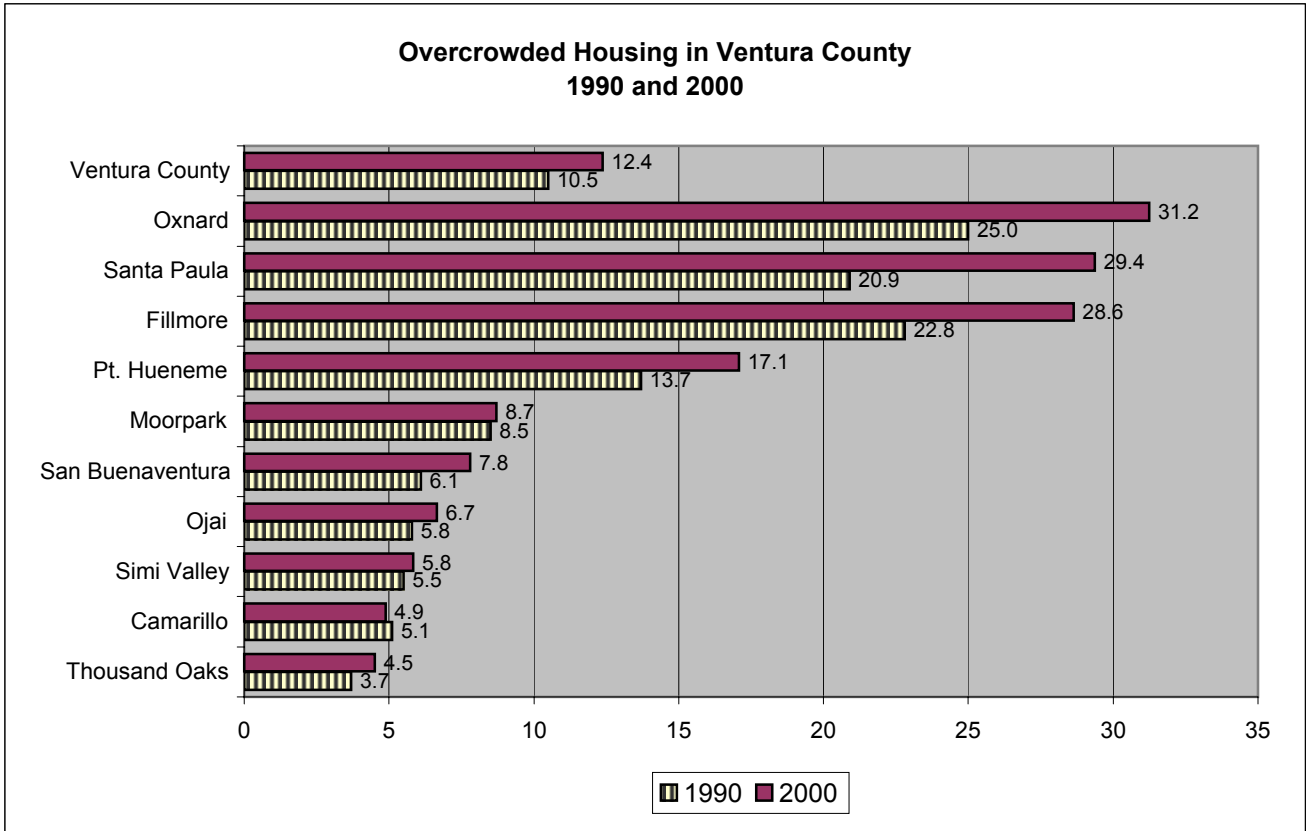

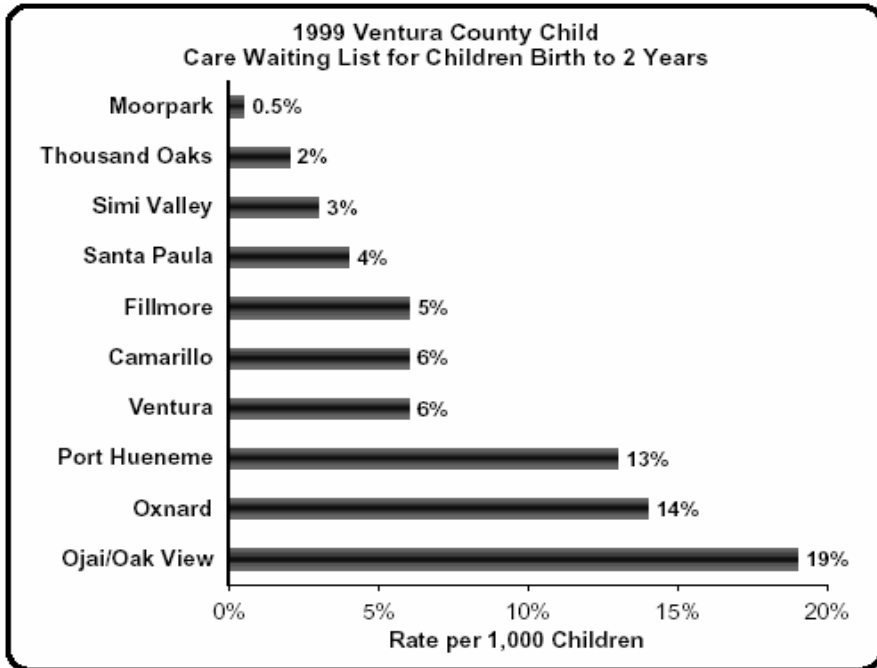

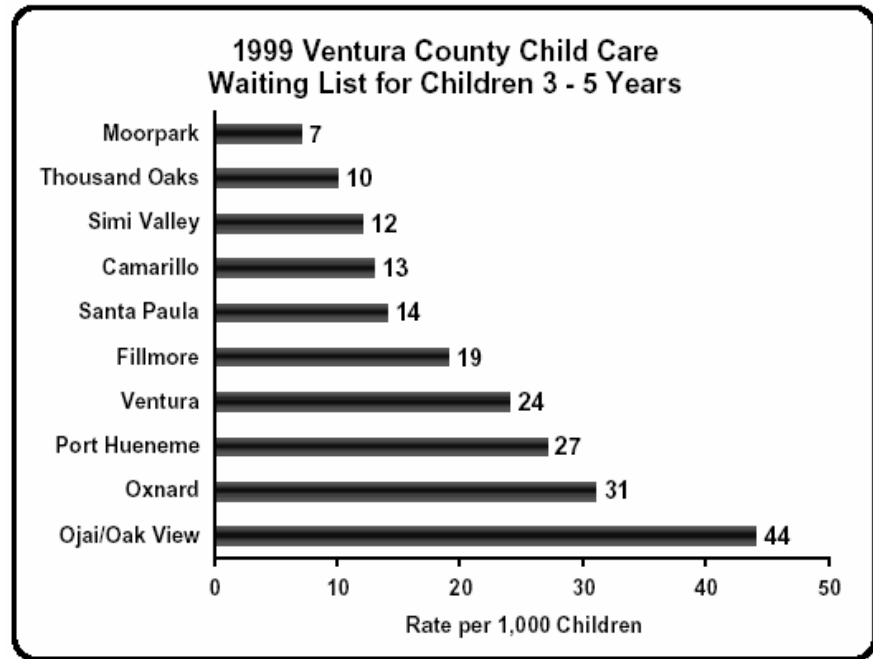

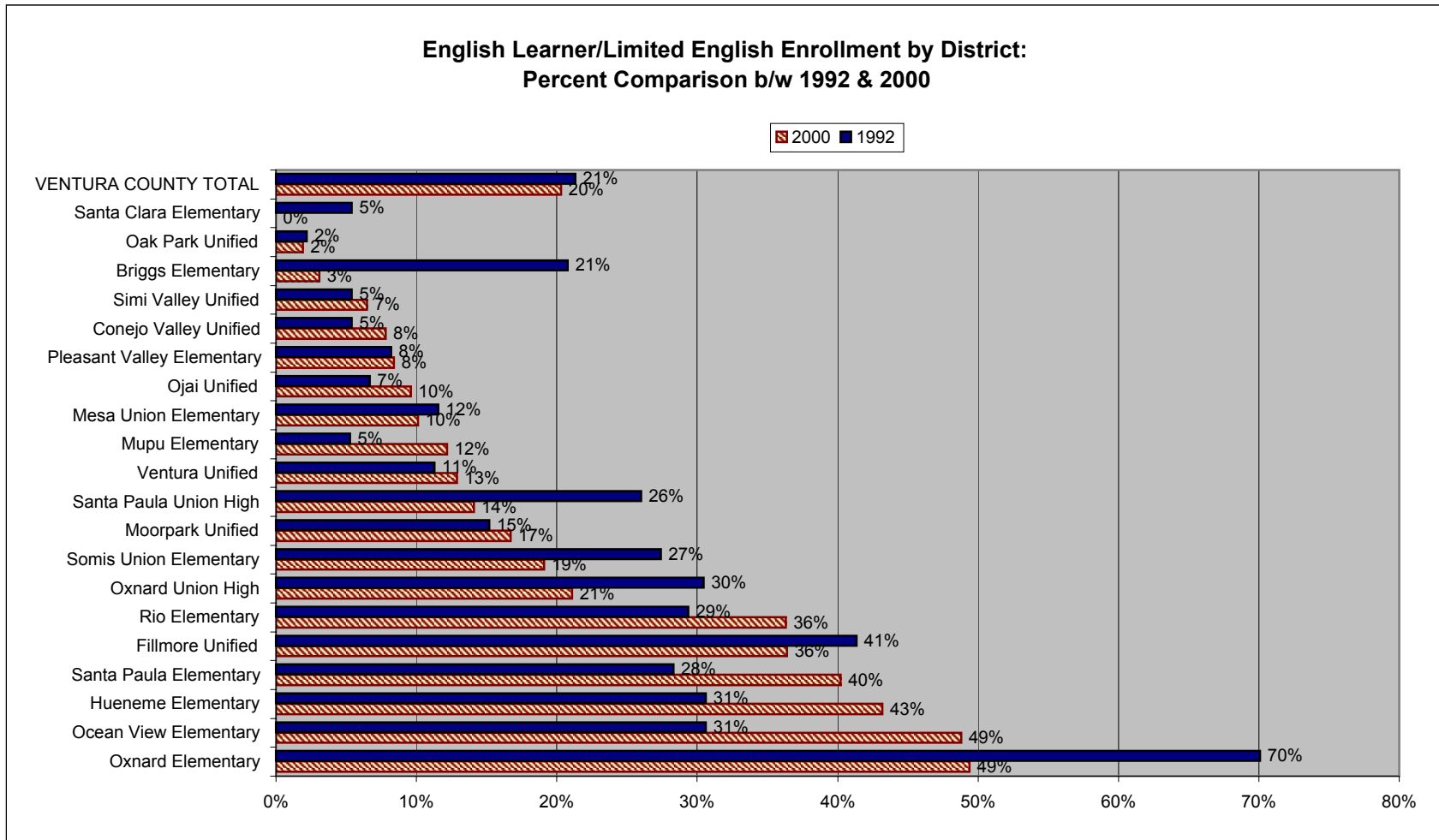

Welfare (TANF/AFDC) Statistics: Ventura County Average Annual Payment per Case



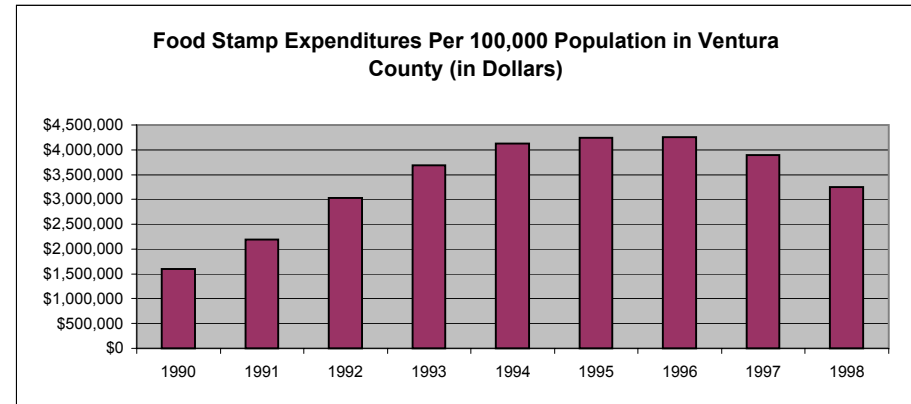
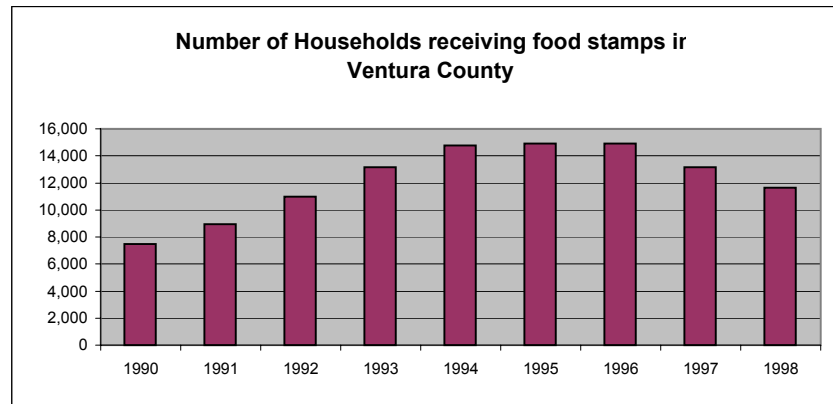

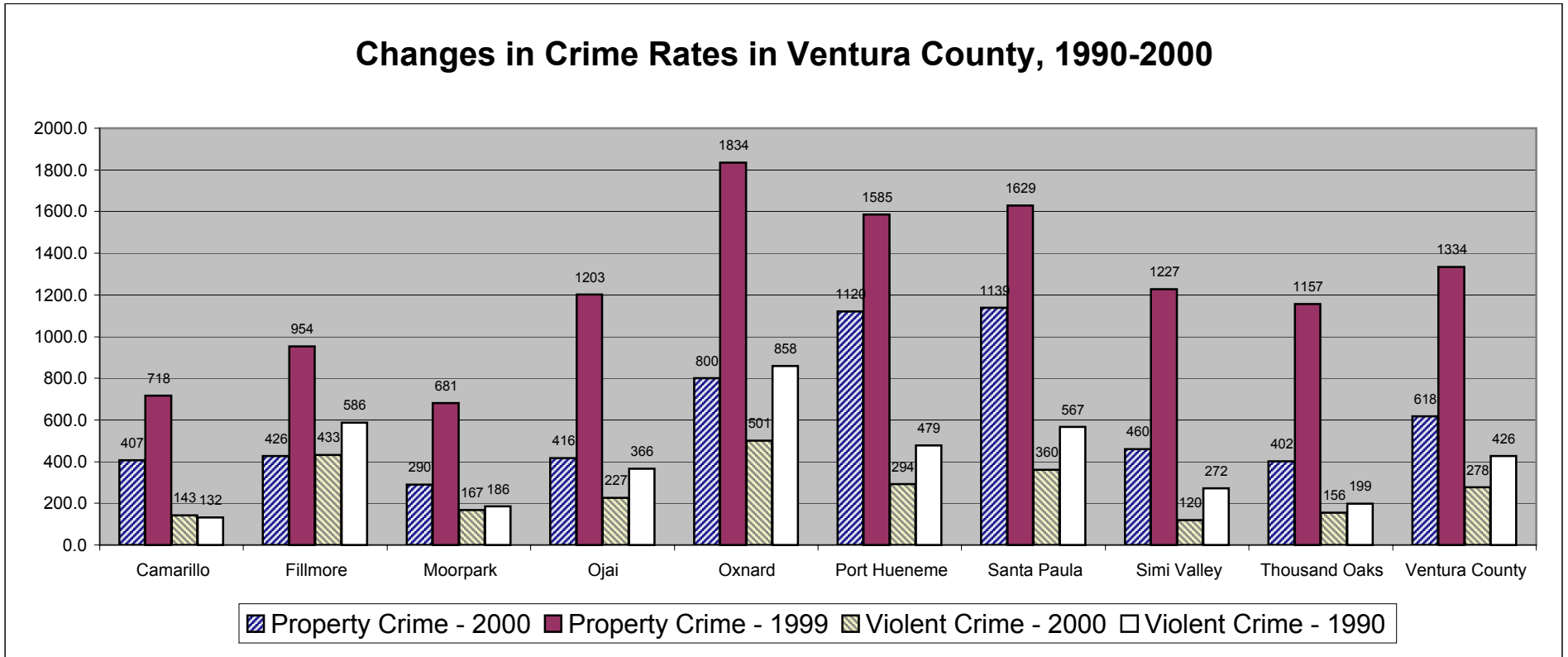
