Schedules

Your freshman year will be pre-selected for you in an effort to ease you into registration. Individual appointments will not be taken for freshman registration. You should receive your schedule in the mail during the middle of summer. If there are any glaring errors, please contact the Center for Academic Resources (x3260) or the Registrar's Office (x3105) where we may be able to make the adjustments (eg. you received a 680 on the Math SAT and you were placed in too low of a math). We do guarantee that every class you are placed in will count toward graduation, but we can not guarantee specific courses for students.

How do you read it? Well, you will find the course name, number, instructor, dates and times all on your schedule. Refer to the Student Advising Handbook for description of course numbering. Changes
