TRIP REDUCTION PROGRAM FEATURES

The following incentives are offered to employees who use alternative modes of transportation at least three days per week on a continuing basis. Individuals who carpool, bicycle, walk, or use public transportation as a means of commuting to work are encouraged to register for the following incentives through the Human Resources Office. If you have any questions regarding the policies listed below please call ext. 3185.

INCENTIVES:

- **Meal Credit:**

Employees who carpool or use alternative modes of transportation at least three days per week will receive a \$25 per month meal credit at the campus dining facilities. Participants must register through the Human Resource Office and must have a valid CLU I.D. card obtained through Campus Safety and Security in order to qualify and receive this benefit.

At the end of each quarter, all balances will be cleared and participants will begin the 1st of the next month with a \$25 credit.

Special "Carpool" permits will be issued through the Human Resource Office which will be used to identify cars which qualify for preferential parking.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM FEATURES

- **Guaranteed Ride Home Program:**

CLU offers a guaranteed ride home to employees registered in the rideshare program in case of emergencies. Human Resources will arrange transportation through security or other volunteers, etc.

- **Rideshare Information:**

Ventura County rideshare information may be obtained through the Human Resources Office or you may call 1-800-286-RIDE.

- **Bicycle Racks:**

CLU has installed bicycle racks in various locations throughout the campus to accommodate those who commute by bicycle.
