The my**CLU** Personal Portal for Students

What is a Portal?

A portal is a website that provides gateway access to multiple electronic resources. The portal is considered a "point of entry" ("*portal*" to the web). CLU portal views are customized to meet the needs of specific members of the Cal Lutheran community; i.e., students, faculty, or staff. CLU's portal is also the starting point to subsites such as Web Mail, WebAdvisor, Library Resources, and more.

More about the my**CLU** Personal Portal

myCLU is the university's web portal. It provides a single gateway to many of the online resources available to students, faculty, and staff. In the past CLU computer users were required to have individual passwords to access each of their accounts. The **myCLU** personal portal minimizes the number of passwords to keep track of by providing one username and one password to access multiple CLU electronic resources.

How do I access the my**CLU** Personal Portal?

Using your computer, open a web browser and type the following URL in the address field: <http://www.callutheran.edu/myclu> Enter your username and password in the right column boxes, and you're in.

What Resources are Available for Students at my**CLU**?

Following is a list of specific resources available in the student view; however, additional resources may be found at **myCLU**.

- Customized announcements based on user's campus group
- CLU news
- Weather
- Web CT
- Web Mail
- WebAdvisor (*includes current class schedule, GPAs, etc*)
- Library Resources (*resources are accessible when off campus through the portal*)
- CLU Employee and Student Directories
- Virus and Microsoft Windows Patches

Other electronic services will be added as the portal matures
