Class Notes:

PA 500 – This preparation course is required for incoming International Students. Continuing International students are strongly encouraged to take it and any other interested students may enroll. The course credits will not apply to the MPPA degree requirements. Two sections will be offered for students’ convenience, one on Monday and one on Wednesday. It’s offered 4-6:30 so that students may take two classes in one evening.

PA 502 - Kathleen Haworth’s class will meet at the Woodland Hills Center and will be delivered partially online. It deals with management styles and issues, a topic of her Ph.D. dissertation which she is currently completing.

PS 550-02 – A second section of Research Methods has been added in Thousand Oaks. Bruce Gillies, Assistant Professor at CLU who teaches in the Undergraduate and MBA programs, will be the instructor. The class will be taught partially online.

PA 582-01 - Brent Morris’ class on Leadership will engage students in active participation in learning modules. He is a Commander with the Sheriff’s Department and currently writing his doctoral dissertation on leadership.

PA 582-05 - The Sacramento class is principally built around a four day trip to the California capitol, February 19-23 (between the Winter and Spring terms).

PA 582-06 – Dr. Gesch’s class on Healthcare Policy will be a hybrid class, partially online, meeting only 3-4 Saturdays in the term. See syllabus for details. Postponed from Winter term.

PA 582-07 – Dr. Harwick will offer a seminar specializing in the thought of Mary Parker Follett’s ‘Prophet of Management” theory.

PSA 595-02 - a second section of Implementation has been added in Thousand Oaks. Dante Honorico will be the instructor. He is the former Chief Deputy of the Ventura County Sheriff’s Department and is now a consultant specializing in change management, cultural diversity and public safety.

PA 599 A/B Thesis/Project – Senior students who have completed the CORE courses and PA 550 may begin the thesis or project process. Please refer to the Thesis Handbook which is posted on the MPPA Community Page.
