The City

Graz is Austria's cultural capital and second largest city, where history and modernity happily coexist. The Schlossberg Castle, once the residence of the Austrian line of the Hapsburgs, sits atop a hill in the center of Graz. Today, the fortress grounds draw tourists and locals alike, hosting open-air concerts and other events. In addition, the UNESCO World Heritage Site known as "Old Town" charms its visitors.

With numerous museums, parks, cafés, and shopping, the 40,000 university students who call Graz home have no problem filling their free time. The sites of Graz are easy to reach with the city's excellent public transportation system, with trams running regularly to all points. Additionally, Graz is situated two hours southwest of Vienna by car and has convenient access to ski areas.

The University

FH-Joanneum is one of Austria's leading Universities of Applied Sciences, with a student body of approximately 2,800. Their mission is to foster growth in their students' social



competencies, entrepreneurial thinking, and enthusiasm for creativity and innovation.



The Program

The Global Business Program at FH Joanneum is an ideal study abroad program for CLU students. With a range of business course offerings taught in English, students have the opportunity to learn in an international and cross-cultural environment alongside students from around the globe. The program includes a month-long German course and orientation prior to the start of classes. In addition to business courses, classes on Austrian culture are available.

Housing

Students make housing arrangements through the Austrian Exchange Service. Study abroad students live in nearby accommodations off campus with other international students. Apartments vary based on availability. Students may have a single or double room. All accommodations are equipped with a shared bathroom and kitchen. Students are responsible for their own meals, as meal plans are not available.

- Excellent public transportation throughout the city


Estimated Semester Costs
