### The City


As a center of international trade since the 17th century, The Netherlands has a spirit of diversity and multiculturalism that is alive and well today. The Hague (known as Den Haag) is no exception. Known as the "International City of Peace, Justice and Security," The Hague offers all the amenities of a big city with a small town feel.

A diverse array of cafés, parks, museums, and shopping areas make The Hague an exciting environment for CLU students to explore. Like most European cities, The Hague is easily accessible by public transportation and walking. With a population of about 475,000, it is home to over 150 international organizations, including the International Criminal Court and the International Court of Justice.

### The University

The Hague University is a vibrant international community with a student body of 17,000 from over 100 different countries. An extensive modern art collection adds to the state-of-the-art facilities. The campus design makes it easy to meet up with friends or find a quiet place to study. A contemporary library and a fitness center are also available for use.

One of the University's basic principles holds that an international group of students and lecturers provide the best opportunity to create a stimulating and exciting learning environment.



### The Program

CLU students enrolled in the International Business and Management Studies (IBMS) program are able to take courses in the areas of Facility Management, International Business, Management Students, and Marketing. While CLU business students have found the course offerings especially beneficial to their course of study, the program is open to students from all majors. The program includes an introductory Dutch Culture and Society course to familiarize students with Dutch history, art, media, political system and economy.

### Housing

Students live in off-campus apartments, and can find assistance selecting accommodations from the International Office at The Hague and their partner, DUWO Accommodate. Meals are the responsibility of the student. All housing comes equipped with a kitchen.
