Located on the north coast of New South Wales, Lismore is a relaxed university town with a population of 45,000. Situated between rainforest and unspoiled beaches, it is a popular destination for outdoor enthusiasts from around the world.

The city offers everything a study abroad student may need, but for students looking for additional adventures, the beautiful beach towns of Byron Bay and the Gold Coast are only 45 minutes and 75 minutes by car, respectively. Daily flights to Sydney are also available.
