The City

Like most European cities, The Hague is easily accessible by public transportation and walking. With a population of approximately 475,000, it is home to over 150 international organizations, including the International Criminal Court and the International Court of Justice.

The University

The campus design makes it easy to meet up with friends or find a quiet place to study. A contemporary library and a fitness center are also available for use.
